Purpose: Find online government services offered by Central, State, District and local government organisations.

The portal is designed as a single-window discovery platform for government services.

3. Government Web Directory

Purpose: Find official websites of Indian government organisations.

The directory can be used to locate websites of ministries, departments, States and Union Territories, judiciary, legislature, autonomous bodies and other government organisations.

This is one of the best starting points when you are unsure whether a government website is genuine.

4. MyGov India

Purpose: Citizen participation and interaction with government initiatives.

MyGov provides opportunities for citizens to participate in discussions, surveys, contests, campaigns and other government initiatives.

5. Digital India

Purpose: Information about India's Digital India programme and digital transformation initiatives.

Digital India focuses on improving digital infrastructure, government services and digital access for citizens.

6. DigiLocker

Purpose: Store, access, share and verify authentic digital documents.

DigiLocker is a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology under the Digital India programme. It provides citizens with access to issued digital documents and certificates.

7. UMANG

Purpose: Access multiple government services through a unified digital platform.

UMANG is designed to provide access to various Central and State government services through a common interface.

8. UIDAI – Aadhaar

Purpose: Aadhaar enrolment, updates, authentication and related services.

UIDAI is the statutory authority responsible for Aadhaar enrolment and authentication and operates under the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology.

Important: Never share your Aadhaar OTP, password or other sensitive credentials with unofficial websites or individuals.

9. Income Tax e-Filing Portal

Purpose: Online income-tax filing and related tax services.

The Income Tax Department's e-Filing portal provides services for filing income-tax returns and forms, checking status, refunds, rectification, e-Verification and other taxpayer services.

10. GST Portal

Purpose: Goods and Services Tax registration, return filing, payments and related GST services.

11. EPFO – Employees' Provident Fund Organisation

Purpose: Provident fund, pension and employee social-security services.

EPFO administers the EPF, Employees' Pension Scheme and Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme and operates under the Ministry of Labour & Employment.

Security tip: EPFO specifically warns users about fake websites and states that its official website is the EPFO domain.

12. ESIC – Employees' State Insurance Corporation

13. Parivahan Sewa

18. CPGRAMS

Purpose: Register and track public grievances relating to government departments and organisations.

CPGRAMS stands for **Centralized Public Grievance Redress And Monitoring System**.

The portal allows users to lodge grievances, check status, submit reminders and provide feedback.

Purpose: File online Right to Information applications with eligible Central Government public authorities.

21. Ministry of Corporate Affairs – MCA

Purpose: Corporate affairs, company registration, LLP services and corporate compliance.

22. Udyam Registration

Purpose: Official MSME/Udyam registration.

The Udyam portal explicitly states that MSME registration is free and paperless and warns against unofficial websites and agencies offering registration services.

Purpose: Information and services relating to the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme.

25. e-Shram

Purpose: National database and services for unorganised workers.

This is preferable to relying on an unofficial third-party list because State government websites and department URLs can change over time.

How to Identify an Official Government Website

A government website should be checked carefully before entering personal or financial information.

1. Check the domain

Many official Indian government websites use:

.gov.in

or other government-controlled domains.

However, users should still verify the website through a trusted government directory.

2. Check the organisation

Look for:

- Government department name
- Ministry name
- Official contact information
- Government emblem where applicable
- Official policies
- Government directory references

3. Avoid unofficial payment websites

Be especially careful when a website asks for payment for services that are officially free.

For example, the official Udyam Registration portal specifically warns users about fake websites and confirms that MSME registration is free.

4. Never share OTPs unnecessarily

Never provide:

- Aadhaar OTP
- PAN information
- Bank OTP
- UPI PIN
- Internet banking password
- UAN password
- Passport login credentials

to an unofficial person or website.

Government Websites vs Private Websites

A website appearing in Google search results does not automatically mean it is a government website.

For important services, users should preferably start with:

National Portal of India

or the relevant official ministry/department website.

The National Portal's Web Directory provides a central way to locate official government websites across ministries, departments, States, Union Territories, judiciary and other government organisations.

The National Portal of India is the main government information portal and provides access to government information and online services.

How can I find an official government website in India?

Use the Government Web Directory available through the National Portal of India or navigate directly from the relevant ministry or department's official website.

Which website is used for Aadhaar services?

UIDAI provides official Aadhaar-related services.

Which website is used for income-tax filing?

The Income Tax Department's e-Filing portal is used for online income-tax returns and related taxpayer services.

Which website is used for GST?

The official GST Portal provides GST registration, return filing, payment and related services.

Which website is used for EPF?

EPFO provides official Employees' Provident Fund services.

Which website is used for passport applications?

Passport Seva, operated by the Ministry of External Affairs, provides passport-related services.

Which website is used for vehicle registration?

Parivahan provides vehicle-registration and other transport-related online services.

Which website is used to download digital government documents?

DigiLocker provides access to issued digital documents and certificates.

Which website is used to find government schemes?

myScheme provides a central platform for discovering government schemes and checking eligibility.

Which website is used to file a government complaint?

CPGRAMS can be used to lodge and track eligible public grievances concerning government departments and organisations.

Which website is used for government jobs?

National Career Service provides employment-related services for job seekers and employers.

Is every website ending in .gov.in automatically safe?

The government domain is an important authenticity signal, but users should still verify the exact domain and organisation before entering sensitive information. When in doubt, start from the National Portal of India's Government Web Directory.
